The petition of TIMMY WELCH AND VIRGINIA WELCH, a resident and domiciliary of the city of Monroe, Parish of Ouachita, State of Louisiana, respectfully represents that:

1.

Made defendants herein are:

NEWELL RUBBERMAID INC. d/b/a BERNZOMATIC, a foreign corporation domiciled in Delaware, upon information and belief, a business authorized to do and doing business in the State of Louisiana, who may be served through its registered agent for service of process, Corporation Process Company, 180 Cherokee Street NE, Marietta, Georgia 30060 via Louisiana Long Arm Statute;
- B. NEWELL RUBBERMAID INC. d/b/a BERNZOMATIC, a foreign corporation domiciled in Delaware, upon information and belief, a business authorized to do and doing business in the State of Louisiana, who may be served through its registered agent for service of process, The Corporation Trust Company, 1209 Orange Street, New Castle, Delaware 19801 via Louisiana Long Arm Statute.
- C. WORTHINGTON INDUSTRIES INCORPORATED, a foreign corporation domiciled in Ohio, who may be served through its registered agent for service of process, Dale T. Brinkman, 200 Wilson Bride Road, Columbus, Ohio 43085 via Louisiana Long Arm Statute.
- D. IRWIN INDUSTRIAL TOOL COMPANY, a foreign corporation domiciled in Delaware, who may be served through its registered agent for service of process, CT Corporation System, 1300 East 9th Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44114 via Louisiana Long Arm Statute.
- E. TRAVELERS PROPERTY CASUALTY COMPANY OF AMERICA, a foreign insurance company, domiciled in Connecticut, authorized to do and doing business in The Louisiana Secretary of State, 8549 United Plaza Blvd., Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70809, as it's registered agent for Service of Process on causes of action arising within the State of Louisiana;

On or about July 3, 2006, plaintiff, TIMMY WELCH, was on private property in the city of Monroe, Parish of Ouachita, State of Louisiana.

3.

On or about July 3, 2006, plaintiff, TIMMY WELCH, was using a one pound Bernzomatic mapp gas cylinder and torch.

On or about July 3, 2006, while using the Bernzomatic mapp gas cylinder and torch, sur and without warning, the gas bottle exploded.

5.

As a result of the above described accident, plaintiff, TIMMY WELCH, sustained the following, injuries:

- (a) Injuries and burns to the face;
- (b) Injuries and burns to the head;
- (c) Injuries and burns to the neck;
- (d) Injuries and burns to the wrist;
- (c) Injuries and burns to the hand:
- (f) Injuries and burns to the abdomen; and
- (g) Psychological Injuries.

6.

As a result of the above described accident, plaintiff, TIMMY WELCH, sustained the following, damages:

- (a) Physical pain and suffering, past and future;
- (b) Mental anguish, humiliation and embarrassment, past and future;
- (c) Physical disability, past and future;
- (d) Medical expenses, past and future;
- (e) Loss of enjoyment of life;
- (f) Loss of earning and earning capacity;
- (g) Disfigurement; and
- (h) Grief, shock, humiliation and emotional distress.

7.

The accident and resulting injuries and damages were caused by the fault, negligence and/or strict liability of the defendants in the following, non-exclusive particulars:

- Failing to properly construct, design, manufacture, composition and/or warn of the unreasonably dangerous gas bottle which is the subject of this litigation;
- b. Selling a product in a defective condition;
- Manufacturing and selling a product which is unreasonably dangerous in construction and/or composition and/or warning or failure to warn;
- Manufacturing and selling a product which is unreasonably dangerous for its intended use;

- e. Failing to give proper warning;
- Failure to properly design, manufacture and assemble the gas bottle in question;
- Failure to safely and properly warn of explosion of the gas bottle in question;
- h. Defective and/or improper composition of materials in the manufacture of the gas bottle in question;
- i. Failure to properly assemble the gas bottle;
- Failure to warn users of its inherent defects and the failure to warn users and purchasers of subsequent modifications through appropriate recall, notices, services bulletins, etc.;
- k. The manufacturer of the gas bottle in question is liable for damages to plaintiff by the characteristics of the product that make it unreasonably dangerous from the reasonably anticipated use of the product;
- The gas bottle in question was unreasonably dangerous in its construction, and/or composition, and/or design, and/or warning, and/or express warranty.

8.

In the alternative, plaintiff shows that the defendants should be held strictly liable for designing, manufacturing and distributing the gas bottle in question when it knew or should have known that it contained defects that presented an unreasonable risk of harm to users of the gas bottle.

Q

In the further alternative, plaintiff shows that the defendants are liable to him as a result of selling and distribution of the gas bottle in question when it knew or should have known of the gas bottle's inherent design and/or manufacturing defects referred to above and is additionally liable for its failure to warn consumers and purchasers of the potential dangers involved through its use.

10.

Plaintiff shows that the defendants, the actual manufacturer of the product in question, are presumed to know of any vices or defects in its original design and manufacture. Therefore, plaintiff shows that the defendants should be held strictly liable for designing, manufacturing and distributing the gas bottle described above when it knew or should have known that it contained defects presenting an unreasonable dangerous or hazardous condition creating an unreasonable risk of harm to plaintiff.

11.

Plaintiff shows that the defendants are liable unto him as a result of the sale of the gas bottle in question when they knew or should have known of its design, composition, construction, and/or manufacturing defects. Defendants are additional liable for their failure to warn customers and

purchasers of the potential dangers involved through its use of the gas bottle in question and/or manufacturing defects.

12.

At the time the gas bottle left the control of the manufacturer, said manufacturer had full knowledge of the dangerous characteristics of the gas bottle in question and was aware of alternative designs which would have rendered the product safe for normal, anticipated use.

13.

The petitioners plead the doctrine of res ipsa loquitur.

WHEREFORE, plaintiffs pray:

- That defendants be served with a copy of this petition and duly cited to appear and answer same;
- That after due proceedings had, there be judgment rendered herein in favor of plaintiffs, TIMMY WELCH AND VIRGINIA WELCH, and against the defendant, NEWELL RUBBERMAID INC. d/b/a BERNZOMATIC, WORTHINGTON INDUSTRIES INCORPORATED, IRWIN INDUSTRIAL TOOL COMPANY, TRAVELERS PROPERTY CASUALTY COMPANY OF AMERICA, in solido, for such damages as are reasonable in the premises, together with the maximum legal interest from date of judicial demand until paid and for all costs of this proceeding;
- 3. For full, general and equitable relief; and
- Prays for trial by jury.
